HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

This month, GEAR UP Birmingham celebrates the establishment and longstanding history of historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs) across the country. This coincides with a time in which Birmingham is preparing for one of the largest economic drivers, the Magic City Classic, a weekend full of activities surrounded by the historic football match-up between two state HBCU teams: [Alabama A&M University](#) and [Alabama State University](#).

HBCUs were first established to serve the education needs of African Americans during a time when they were being denied access to universities/colleges across the country, eventually becoming the popular source of postsecondary education for African American people. Even with the success of integration in America's postsecondary schools, HBCUs still remain a vital ingredient to the nation's education system. Recent research suggests that graduates of HBCUs have a higher rank of well-being compared to their peers at other institutions. They are also more likely to connect with a professor as a mentor while at school, and they leave school with a strong alumni support network (*Inside Higher Ed, 2015*). There are over 100 Historically Black Colleges and Universities across the country, and Alabama is proud to be the home to 15 of those schools, making it one of the top states with the most historically black colleges and universities. GEAR UP Birmingham is proud to partner with two of Alabama's HBCUs – Alabama State University and Lawson State Community College.

GEAR UP PARENT AND STUDENT AMBASSADORS

Parent engagement is a key component to ensuring college readiness for our students. To help determine the specific needs and desires of our community, GEAR UP Birmingham developed a student and parent ambassador program. These ambassadors not only help to facilitate and strengthen the relationship between the GUB staff and families, but also aid in volunteering at events and activities throughout the year.

GEAR UP Birmingham will host the Magic City College Experience Presentation Competition on October 24 at [Lawson State Community College](#). Tenth grade students will participate in a school based competition in which students are afforded the opportunity to conduct research, write an argumentative essay and present findings on **The Relevance of Historically Black Colleges and Universities in 21st Century, Presumed Post-Racial Society**. Top 10th grade school-based winning teams from each Birmingham City High School will advance to the district level, where they will have an opportunity to compete for the district competition winner title. The goal of this event is to educate our students on the impact of HBCUs in past and current history.
